Nagasaki port, in the shape of a Crane, was the only port open to the world for a long period of time. Many cultural seeds were scattered here creating budding flowers to help form the new Japan.

Since then, time has passed by . . .

On the 27th March 2004, yet another cultural seed sprouted up in the land around Nagasaki port.

Nagasaki Seaside Park was created as a place for people to relax near the harbour. It is around 6.5 hectares and has a canal running through the middle of the park which is split into 3 sections: Aqua Garden, Land Plaza and Canal Promenade.

Can you see the babbling stream of spring water running down from the mountain; the promenade where you can enjoy the smell of the flowers; the sunshine filtering through the foliage; the fish playing in the canal as you look down from the bridges? We hope that you can experience all of this in the space set between the luxuriant trees and grass by sea.

We also hope that, just like the forest, the seed inside your heart can you grow and flourish.

1. Location

Nagasaki Seaside Park is located close to Glover Garden and Dutch Slope in the Minami-yamate and Higashi-yamate areas. If you drive along the Nagasaki Dejima Road, which links central Nagasaki and the national expressway, you will see the park directly in front of you.



2. Events

Overlooking the sea, this large grassy open space can also be used for staging events. Occasionally, small concerts are held on the public stage. There are many usages for this area, and it is limited only by ideas.

3. Seasons

There are many trees and flowers in bloom throughout the year. The change in colour reflects the gradual flow of the seasons.



4. Familiarization with Art

The park is a place where people can feel close to nature and art, due to its close proximity to the Prefectural Art Museum. This adds to the park's charm and enables the space to thrive.




Aqua Garden
